

The manuscript collection of the Saranac Lake Free Library's Adirondack Research Room consists of more than 18 linear feet of manuscript material. Included in the collection are writings of Adirondack notables, including Alfred L. Donaldson, author of the first written history of the Adirondacks; Martha Reben and William Chapman White. The manuscripts were created from 1813 to 2009 and document the interaction between lives of Adirondack residents and the environment in Saranac Lake and the Adirondack Park.
