Thirty-two librarians and trustees attended the meeting held at the Headquarters on December 12th. The speaker was Mr. Matthew Tyborowski, Field Representative of the Social Security Administration. Mr. Tyborowski explained the provision of the Social Security Laws and the steps that must be taken to obtain the maximum benefits.

The Annual Report forms were mailed to the member librarians shortly before Christmas. Miss Walter would like to remind librarians that one copy should be sent to the Library Extension Division and one to her at the Headquarters, before February first, 1957. This is very important, as the System's State Aid cannot be calculated until all the reports are in. This in turn governs the payment of the Annual Grant to the Member Libraries.

This Newsletter, the Acquisitions Lists and the Book Reviews, were printed on the Multilith machine which the System recently purchased. Catalog cards for all books processed at the Headquarters will also be printed by the same process.

Use of this machine will speed up the processing of books, and will make it possible to print many of the forms used by the System, thus lowering printing costs.

All member librarians are asked to send a list of all organizations in their communities, with the names of the presidents, to Miss Walter or Miss Ingalls at the Headquarters. This information is needed to complete our mailing list.
