Long Range Plan

MISSION

The Hammond Library of Crown Point, NY, provides materials, references and services to meet the personal, educational and professional needs of the residents of Crown Point, NY, and surrounding communities. There is a special emphasis on stimulating children's and young adult's interests and helping them develop an appreciation for reading and learning.

LIBRARY ROLES

The Hammond Library maintains a circulating collection of books on an ongoing basis to provide reading entertainment, reference, and current affairs information to the residents of Crown Point and beyond. We use the Clinton, Essex, Franklin (CEF) Library System to circulate new books into our system. The Library provides interlibrary loans services in response to special requests. Hammond Library serves as a "Door to Learning" for preschool children and elementary students through Summer Reading Programs. The Hammond Library provides space for literacy programs, agencies from the county or private sector to meet with clients. The Library also serves as a central place for exploring creative outlets such as craft classes and artists in residence.

GOALS

Patrons of the library will have access to a wide range of reading materials to serve their educational and recreational interests.

Have a monthly preschool reading program.

Have a monthly reading and craft program for kindergarten to 3rd graders.

To have a regular Genealogy group once a month, for anyone that wants to learn how to start their family tree history, or to further their research. And to have one computer available for Ancestry.com

OBJECTIVES

The library will be fully automated, so that we will be able to better serve the residents of Crown Point.

We will serve the communities around us as a reading, recreational, and resource center.

To have repairs and improvements to the basement, windows and roof, as well as any others that may occur.

ACTIONS

Funding will be sought for capital. Improvements to the basement to keep it dry to improve storage and to repair or replace the roof, and to have the upper windows removed, and central air system add to the building.

We will offer craft classes to the residents of Crown Point and surrounding communities.
